What to Expect on Sunday

Q: What do people wear?

Come as you are. You'll find people with t-shirts, collared shirts, jeans, jackets, casual wear, ties, and even shorts when it is warm.

Q: Is there childcare?

Nursery at Immanuel provides families with children aged birth to age 5 a safe, fun place for their young ones to stay during Sunday School, Sunday morning worship, and occasionally during other ministries. A nursing room is also available for mothers with a video feed of the worship service.

Q: What is the service like?

Each service is around 75-90 minutes long. We typically have a short time of welcome and announcements before we start worship.

Q: What is the music like?

We play a mix of hymns and modern worship songs, not for entertainment, but for full congregational participation. Performance isn't our thing: singing is.

Q: What is the preaching like?

Sermons are expositional, verse-by-verse Scripture-saturated proclamations of the gospel of Jesus Christ in both the Old and New Testaments.
